

## SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

### For Iron Workers District Council of Southern Ohio & Vicinity Benefit Trust

This is a summary of the annual report of the Iron Workers District Council of Southern Ohio & Vicinity Benefit Trust, EIN 31-0557391, Plan No. 501, for period February 01, 2015 through January 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Aetna Life Insurance Co., Community Insurance Company, and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company to pay life insurance, stop loss, PPO and ADD claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending January 31, 2016 were \$9,243,277.

#### Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$36,768,800 as of January 31, 2016, compared to \$40,573,163 as of February 01, 2015. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$3,804,363. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$50,286,958, including employer contributions of \$40,576,259, employee contributions of \$9,880,068, and earnings (losses) from investments of (\$169,369).

Plan expenses were \$54,091,321. These expenses included \$4,788,027 in administrative expenses, and \$49,303,294 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
